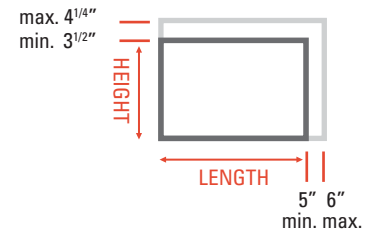

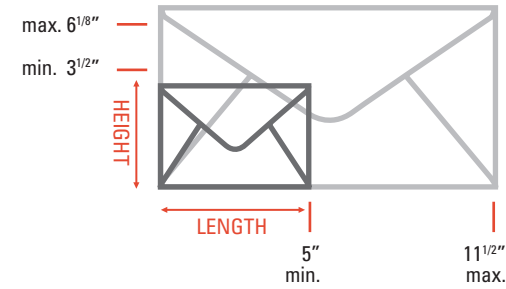

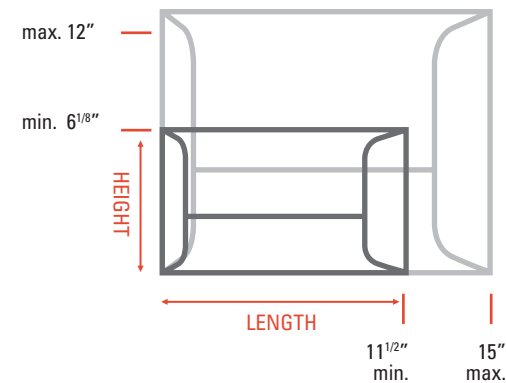


### ASPECT RATIO

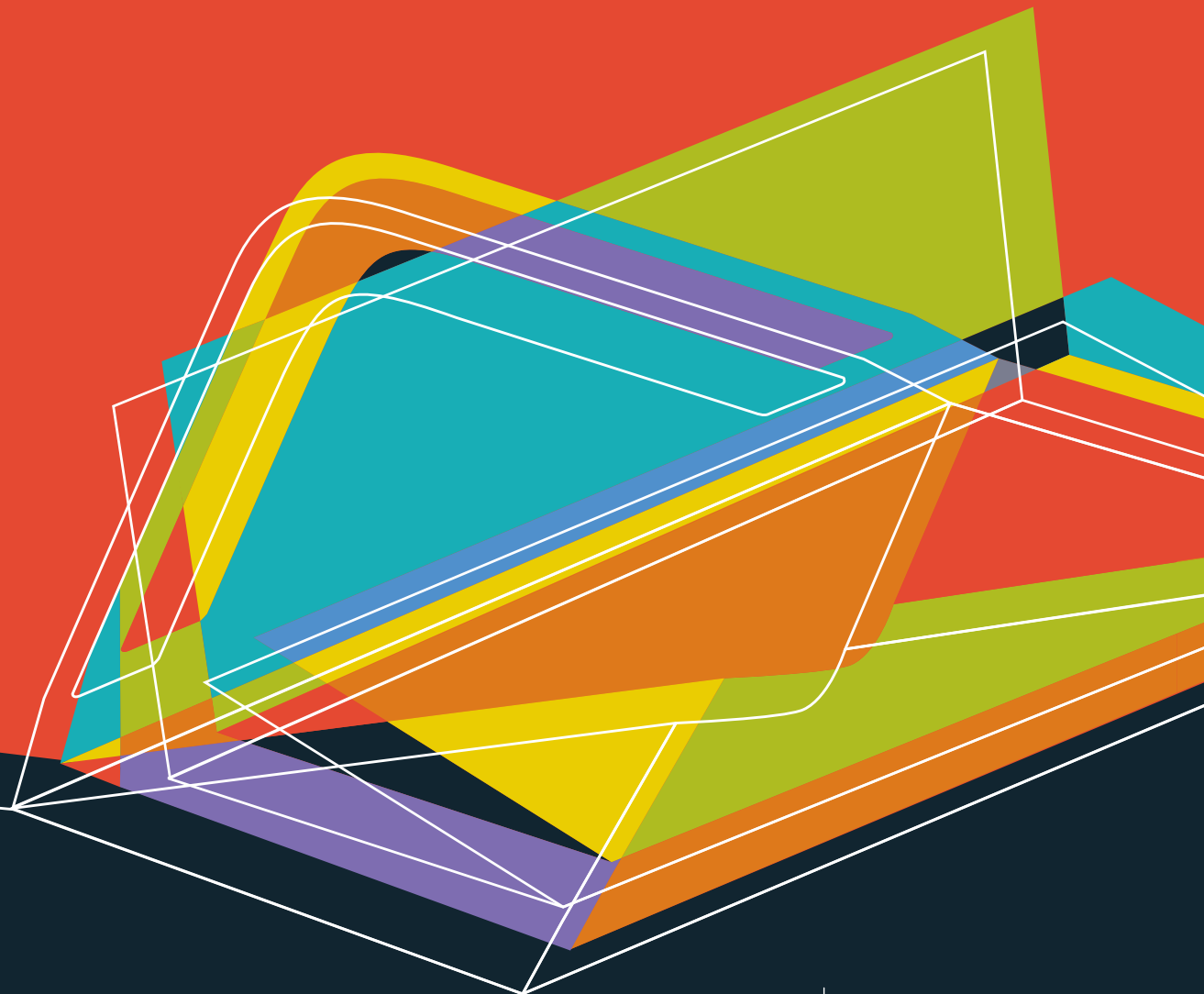
